DURC Soccer registration numbers were higher this year than in 2013 (259, up from 230). This was a welcome surprise to the DURC committee that had put in a great effort into promoting the club across the summer months, providing an online self-registration system and accepting many late registrations.

A comparison between the number of teams that were able to formed in the last two years is:

There was an increase in the SSG Teams and the revival of the Foal category (U5). In 2015 the Foal (U5) age group was revived by Afton Bianchi and the age group ended up with a squad of 10. Afton not only revived the Foals but played for the AAL/2's and coached the U8/Reds. For her efforts, Afton was named the DURC Club Person of the Year (The Wilcockson Shield).

At the end of the Main Competition, the U12/4's, U13/5's, O35's, AAL/2's and the SL/R entered the Finals series. This was an excellent position for DURC to be in at the start of the Finals series. Unlike the Main Competition which was virtually rain free, the onset of continual rain forced GDFa to restructure the Finals series into a "sudden death" 2 round series instead of the traditional 3 round event.

The initiative to create a Super League side in 2014 was initially driven by Mike Jones and Raff Scognamiglio. With players mainly drawn from what was a good 2013 U21/1's side. The squad was coached by Feraydon Charoosaie and managed by Ken Tompsett who was named the DURC manager of the year. The SL/1's just missed out on entering the Finals series but the SL/R's became Grand Champions by winning their Grand Final. This is an astonishing accomplishment in their first year and 2015 will no doubt see equal if not greater goals reached on their way to Premier League.

The O35's were sadly knocked out during their Semi Final and finished in fourth place. The U12/4's were also knocked out in their Semi Final and also finished in fourth place.

AAL/2's went through to their Grand Final but sadly lost and finished in third place.

The U13/5's were in the enviable position of being ranked first in the Main Comp with a GD of 103. Finishing the Main Competition undefeated they did not disappoint and went on to win their Grand Final and become Grand Champions. Their coach David Squire was also named DURC's Coach of the year. This was a tremendous turn around for a team that just missed out on entering the Final Series in 2013.

2014 is my second year of involvement with the DURC committee and I would like to thank the committee and the DURC coaches and managers for their support throughout the year. 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**TREASURER'S REPORT**

**FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2014**

It is with pleasure that I present the Profit and Loss and the Balance Sheet for the financial year ended 30<sup>th</sup> September 2014.

The Club continues to be in a strong financial position though contrary to what was predicted in the 2013 report this is not at first glance obvious.

Due to operational needs the financial year end was moved to the 30<sup>th</sup> of September to allow time for all of our sporting interests to be finalised to better reflect the true nature of the club season expenditure and income. As a result the transitional period for this year has added 3 months to our trading.

This and as mentioned last year the tidying up of previous payment methods has created financial transactions which under traditional accounting practices were due the prior season. This is never more obvious than in soccer's financial result which as was advised last year would be the balancing of the large net profit for 2013.

As such and with my apologies a true reflection will not be realised until next year as continued evolution of modernisation of payment methods for liabilities, record keeping strategies and further refinement of both purchasing, registration and sales methods make the process more seamless and less taxing on all involved.

To this end the committee based on my recommendation has opened a savings account to enable us to take advantage of higher interest from the bank than what is paid to the cheque account. This is paid monthly and the only condition being a minimum balance. Given the clubs high funds turnover and the suppliers monthly invoicing this change is self-explanatory.

The net loss is attributable though not limited to payments made for services and operations in previous financial years. Finalisation of the outstanding expenses from previous canteen and gear steward purchases. An increase in administration costs, eg, Telstra, Bank fees, insurances et al though not noticeable in comparison to last year all add up. The further reduction to zero value of some plant items, a replenishing of saleable stock though we still have the legacy of previous purchases hindering our cash retention. Upgrading of the storage facilities for saleable stock. Upgrading of the internet to be more in line with current trends in digital media. Purchase of new strip for our successful super league sides, the committee to this end decided to modernise all the playing strip over the ongoing seasons. The failure of our initial purchase of soccer balls and the agreement to modernise our netball teams to make it more obvious who we are by the purchase of monogrammed netballs and bags in keeping with opposition trends and to heighten exposure given netball will be on the world stage next year as a result of the upcoming world cup.

All these are reflected in our stock takes and increased administration costs.

It is the continued prime objective every year of the Management Committee to record slightly better than a break-even result in order to provide the Club with long term financial stability and to ensure the continued growth and development of our three sporting activities.

The club has recorded a deficit of \$34929.24, (deficit of \$16512.47 in 2013) which in turn takes the balance of our Club usable funds to \$38606.24 (\$83729.04 in 2013) remembering the extended transitional period and previous expenses, at this time apart from ongoing monthly Telstra and banking administration costs the club has no outstanding debt.

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Thanks must go to Margaret and David Wilcockson for their efforts over the past 18 months where they took over the canteen under trying circumstances and continued to keep it viable.

Margaret and David in keeping with the committee intent have instigated new processes and procedures for the operational aspect and accountability in the canteen. Margaret and David have decided to try retirement again and the word thanks is not strong enough to describe the assistance given to me in my duties.

This year the Canteen contributed a surplus of \$4881.15 for the year, (surplus of \$2402.63 in 2013). This figure is based on takings of \$11,186.37 expenses of \$6305.22 (an amount of \$46.85 has been overpaid to one of the suppliers and will be credited next year). \$795.95 was paid based on demands from reputable suppliers for the 2012 season (prior to current management) and cannot be disputed due to lack of invoices. Given the reduction in sales prices the net is exceptional and exceeds previous years. This doesn't include gear sales and registrations that Margaret and David also actioned on behalf of the club.

A special thanks to our gear stewards Andrea Martic and Jo Jeffrey, and the Management Committee for their assistance in making sure everyone was geared up and ready to go for the season. An extra special thanks to Andrea who was saddled with the unenviable job of sorting out the stock she inherited and also as our at times unrecognised social organiser and to that end her husband Ollie as well. To Jo for her modern and progressive ideas to prevent the sport of netball from going stale in terms of fashion and presentation.

The financial outcomes of the three sporting activities are as follows.

Soccer recorded a deficit of \$18198.26 (surplus of \$17385.72 in 2013) refer to opening statement.

Netball recorded a surplus of \$2798.48 (deficit of \$15.20 in 2013) A review is being conducted in relation to fees as this figure contains registrations from the 2013 season and two (2) night comp registrations)

Cricket recorded a surplus of \$891.00 (deficit of \$553.67 in 2013). This figure is not complete as all records have not been realised.

Thank you to my fellow executive committee members Michael Jones, Sue Woodhouse and Ash Ariyaratnam for their assistance and also continued willingness to accept change. Your continued assistance in my role is greatly appreciated.

Congratulations to Paul Briozzo, Karen Banks, Greg Berriman and their respective committees for the successful running of their individual sports.

Continued thanks to Suzanne Tritton for managing the netball umpiring payments. To Ed Brookton, Jo Cambourn and Megan Farebrother for the work done in registrations.

Thanks also to John Forbes and Mark Hutchinson for their assistance. Welcome to Andrew Taylor who is out gathering sponsorship for the club to further boost our finances.

Also a special thank you to Danielle Corbett for her efforts in assisting me in maintaining the books and accounts in an accurate and efficient manner since I took over as Treasurer last year.

In summary, the Club remains in a strong financial position but cannot become static and we look forward with confidence to the coming year.
