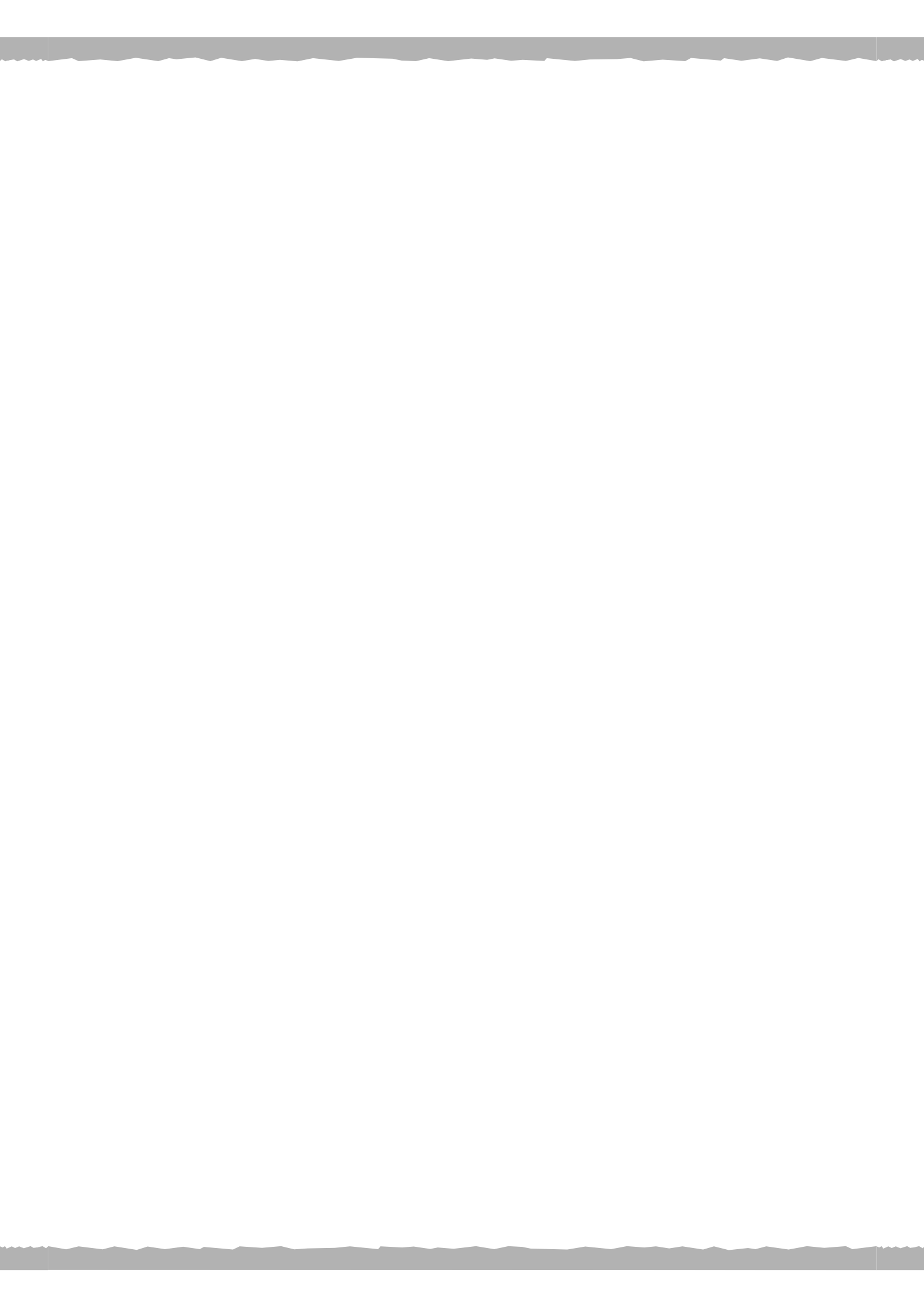

## **TREASURER'S REPORT**

### **FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2013**

It is with pleasure that I present my first Profit and Loss and the Balance Sheet for the financial year ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2013.

The formatting has been changed to present the summarisation of the year at a higher level in an attempt to reduce the postings needed to be examined. The full accounts and receipting are provided to the auditor for forensic examination to confirm the figures supplied.

The Club continues to be in a strong financial position though this at first examination would appear not to be evidenced in the balances presented. Taking into account the extra payments this year is more in line with the 2011 period.

This will be reflected next year as the integration of new payment methods for liabilities (e.g. internet banking and direct debits for ongoing monthly obligation), record keeping strategies and further refinement of both purchasing, registration and sales methods make the process more seamless and less taxing on all involved.

This anomaly will with the assistance provided by everyone from the new committee and further refinement of accounting and record keeping strategies make the balances be a truer reflection of the fiscal state of the club.

The net loss is attributable though not limited to payments made for services and operations in previous financial years, the reduction to zero value of some plant items, a replenishing of saleable stock (reflected in our stock takes) and the outstanding fees due the club.

It is the objective of the Management Committee to record slightly better than a break-even result each year in order to provide the Club with long term financial stability and to ensure the continued growth and development of our three sporting activities.

To this end registrations remained at 2012 levels, discounts were introduced for multiple registrations (family reduction) prices were reduced in the canteen and also for saleable goods plus an incentive discount when purchasing more than one item of gear/club merchandise.

The club has recorded a deficit of **\$16512.47**, (surplus of \$ 5,204 in 2012) which in turn takes the balance of our Club usable funds to \$ 83729.04 (\$97571 in 2012). This figure is different from the balances shown on bank statements as payments and deposits will appear on the July statements that are attributable to 2013 in keeping with prior recording.

From this year (previous entries excluded) the record keeping will be done on a cash basis as opposed to an accrual basis this then prevents over hangs from previous years affecting the return. In short no matter the date of the invoice or payment it will be accounted for as at the date of receipt or payment of same.

Congratulations must be made to our new canteen managers, Margaret & David Wilcockson and all those who have helped in the canteen throughout the year as the contribution from the canteen in relation to the Club's activities and financial return is Paramount to the Club's success.

This year the Canteen contributed a surplus of **\$2402.63** for the year, (surplus of \$5208 in \$2012). This figure is based solely on banking figures (takings less cash purchases) less payments made via cheque or direct deposit. Also of note the reduction is attributable to change in management structure, give away's, reduction in prices, purchase incentives and payments made for prior year supplies and next year will present a true reflection of the success of the canteen.

Due to the expiration of some stock the committee has advised Margret and David to dispose of the relevant goods (ullage) and this will be reflected next year in the write down figure.

A special thanks to our gear stewards Sven and Kathy, and the Management Committee for their assistance in making sure everyone was geared up and ready to go for the season.

The financial outcomes of the three sporting activities are as follows.  
Soccer recorded a surplus of \$17385.72 (surplus of \$1810 in 2012).  
Netball recorded a **deficit of \$15.20** (deficit of \$386 in 2012).  
Cricket recorded a **deficit of \$553.67** (surplus of \$3057 in 2012).

Administration expenses include but are not limited to insurance, telephone, bank charges and audit fees. Council rates have not been added to any particular entity as the canteen, soccer and netball use the facilities provided by Parramatta council and this will be shown as a separate entry.

Thank you to my fellow executive committee members Mike, Raff and Jo for their assistance and also willingness to accept change in particular the implementation of the internet banking after all the security details were finalised. Your assistance in my moving into the role is greatly appreciated.

Congratulations to Paul Briozzo, Karen Banks, Greg Berriman and their respective committees for the successful running of their individual sports.

A big thank you goes to Suzanne Triton who has gathered all the banking details for the netball umpires so direct deposits can be made as opposed to the distribution of cheques or cash. To Ed Brockton and Jo for the work done on outstanding registration payments.

Thanks also to the outgoing treasurer Paul Reid and Secretary Kath Scriven for their assistance with my queries and also John Forbes and Mark Hutchinson for clarification in matters I had little exposure to.

Also a special thank you to Danielle Corbett for her efforts in assisting me in maintaining the books and accounts in an accurate and efficient manner since I took over as Treasurer Mid-year.

In summary, the Club is in a strong financial position and we should look forward with confidence to the coming year.
